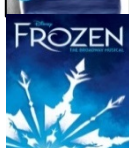
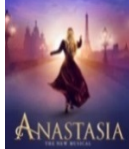
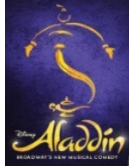


WHAT'S PLAYING AT HAGEY TOURS?
